EACH ANIMAL MUST HAVE A RABIES VACCINATION

REQUIREMENTS FOR ENTERING:

1. **PREREGISTER** by mail before Saturday, August 15, 2009.
2. If you are showing as a club or group please mark entry form, "showing as a club". Give name of club.
3. Exhibitors please note you are allowed UP TO but NOT TO EXCEED 15 ANIMALS PER FARM OR FAMILY UNIT! Total number of 15 animals beef and dairy combined.
No more than two animals may be preregistered per lot.
4. Any animal or group of animals NOT PREREGISTERED WILL NOT BE ALLOWED to participate. NO EXCEPTIONS.
5. Read carefully the RULES FOR ENTERING on the back of the Livestock Entry Form.
6. You MUST list Department number, Class letter and Lot number for each entry.
7. You MUST call one of the Dairy Superintendents to reserve your barn space for the number of animals you intend to bring.
8. No animal can be entered or shown as purebred unless it has been recorded in the recognized book of record for its respective breed and stand on the record in the name of the exhibitor. The Superintendent of Dairy Cattle may examine the certificates of registry and transfer on arrival.
9. a) Each animal MUST have a RABIES VACCINATION 30 days before show date and have a certificate signed and dated by a veterinarian. Dairy Superintendent will check all papers on arrival.
b) The Woodstock Fair recommends vaccinations against IBR, BVD, PI3, BRSV and LEPTOSPIROSIS.
c) Any animals found with contagious diseases such as pinkeye, ringworm, hoof rot, warts, etc. will immediately be removed from the Fair.
10. Animals MUST arrive by 8:00 PM on Friday, Sept. 4, with all required health papers and permits. Animals may be brought to the fairgrounds on Thursday, Sept. 3, between 12:00 PM and 8:00 PM. This rule applies to all exhibitors. Enter at the North Gate only.
11. If for any reason you cannot attend after PREREGISTERING, you MUST notify the Dairy Superintendent in order to be eligible for the following year.
12. For department specific questions contact superintendents listed above. For additions and corrections to entries, please contact the Superintendent of Entries at (860)928-3246 ext. 104.
13. Cattle MUST be watered in their assigned space or at the wash rack.
14. Cattle will be released at 6:00 PM, Monday.
15. STRAIGHT JUDGING IN ALL CLASSES. All judging results are final.
16. Premiums will be paid by mail before September 30, 2009.
17. NO HORNED CATTLE ALLOWED to enter the Fair.
NO scurs over 1 1/2 inches long.
18. Calves under 3 months of age and not vaccinated will be segregated.
19. Youth exhibitors participating in both the open and youth shows MUST be in control of their animal without assistance or risk forfeit of the premiums. (At superintendents' discretion).
20. All exhibitors and their help are required to wear shirts and shoes at all times.
21. Exhibitors need to register to be judged for Herdsmanship.
22. Animal must be shown in its individual class before it can be shown in a group class.

2. If you are showing as a club or group please mark entry form, "showing as a club". Give name of club.
3. Exhibitors please note you are allowed UP TO but NOT TO EXCEED 15 ANIMALS PER FARM OR FAMILY UNIT! Total of 15 animals is beef and dairy combined.
No more than two animals may be preregistered per lot.
4. Any animal or group of animals NOT PREREGISTERED WILL NOT BE ALLOWED to participate. NO EXCEPTIONS.
5. Read carefully the RULES FOR ENTERING on the back of the Livestock Entry Form.
6. You MUST list Department number, Class letter and Lot number for each entry.
7. You MUST call one of the Dairy Superintendents to reserve your barn space for the number of animals you intend to bring.
8. No animal can be entered or shown as purebred unless it has been recorded in the recognized book of record for its respective breed and stand on the record in the name of the exhibitor. The Superintendent of Dairy Cattle WILL examine the certificates of registry and transfer on arrival.
 - a) ANIMALS ENTERED IN THE YOUTH SHOW MUST BE OWNED OR LEASED BY THE YOUTH EXHIBITOR. YOUTHS MUST SHOW THEIR OWN ENTRIES to receive youth premiums. The ONLY EXCEPTIONS multiple entries. Papers will be checked
 - b) Grade animals may be shown in the Youth Show, but MAY NOT enter the Open Show.
 - c) Exhibitors in the Youth Show MUST NOT have reached their 19th birthday by September 1, 2009.
