REQUIREMENTS FOR ENTERING:

1. **PREREGISTER** by mail **BEFORE Saturday, August 14, 2010.**
2. **ALL ENTRIES MUST BE PREREGISTERED. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
3. Read carefully the **RULES FOR ENTERING** on the back of the **General Entry Form.**
4. A maximum of **6 finished articles** will be accepted per exhibitor.
5. No more than **3 articles per lot** within a Class. One class per item, determined by Exhibitor.
6. All articles **MUST** have been completed **within the last year.**
7. Visible names or labels **MUST** be covered before entry.
8. Framed articles **MUST** be ready for hanging on a **sturdy hanger.** **No exceptions.**
9. In needlework classes, the area of stitched work is measured.
10. Classes A thru I must be crafted by **hand** (without machine) by the exhibitor.
11. Due to space limitations, large items may be restricted.
12. The Superintendents have the right to reject any article that is not in suitable condition for exhibiting.
13. You **MUST** list the **Department number, Class letter** and **Lot number** for each item entered on entry blank.
14. **Bring all preregistered entries to the fairgrounds on Receiving Day, Wednesday, September 1, between 10:00 AM and 7:00 PM. Enter at the North Gate only.**
15. **ALL ENTRIES MUST BE REMOVED AT DESIGNATED TIMES ONLY: NO VEHICLES** on grounds before 9:00 PM Monday.
NO EXCEPTIONS.
Monday 7:00 PM to 9:00 PM
Tuesday 5:00 PM to 7:00 PM
16. Any item not picked up by 7:00 PM on Tuesday will become the property of the Woodstock Fair and will be disposed of accordingly.

18. **Premiums will be paid by mail before September 30, 2010. JUDGING WILL BE DONE BY THE DANISH SYSTEM,** (except where otherwise stated.) **All judging results are final.**

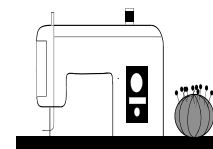

STATE QUILT CONTEST

RULES OF CONTEST:

WHO MAY ENTER: This contest is open to all residents of Connecticut: men, women and juniors. If entered by juniors, they will be judged with all adult entries.

HOW TO ENTER: Any resident of Connecticut entering the Quilt Contest at any fair that is a member of The Association of Connecticut Fairs is automatically competing in the local contest. Contestants may enter the contest in as many fairs as they wish **until** they win First Prize. They will then represent that fair in the state contest at the spring meeting of the Association.

JUDGING: The Association of Connecticut Fairs will furnish judges' score sheets to each fair and the contestant will receive these sheets at the end of the contest. Judging will be based on overall appearance, workmanship and originality. **All decisions of the judges are final.**

LOCAL CONTEST: The winner of the quilt contest will receive a blue ribbon from The Association of Connecticut Fairs and will become eligible to submit their entry to the state contest. In the event a fair only receives one entry in the contest, and that entry is worthy of first prize, the association rosette **MUST** be awarded to that entry.

STATE CONTEST: The state contest will be held at the Association of Connecticut Fairs spring meeting, date and time to be announced. The Secretary of each Fair must contact the winner of their local contest and provide information about reservations and other contest information. The Association of Connecticut Fairs does not contact the contestants.

The following prizes will be awarded in each category:
1st Prize: 50.00 2nd Prize: 35.00 3rd Prize: 15.00

Categories:

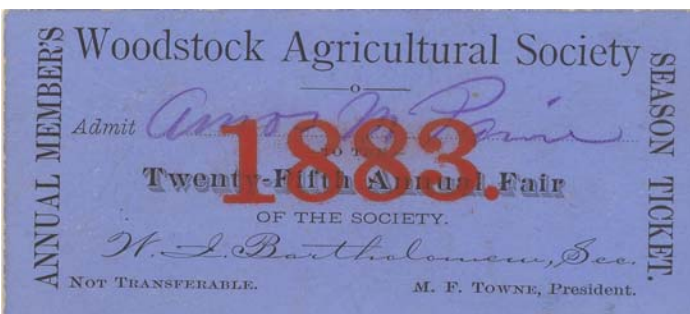
1. Hand-Applique
2. Patchwork No tied quilts - No pre-cut quilt kits

Criteria:

1. All work **must** be completed by an individual quilt maker.
2. Work can be pieced by hand or by machine, but applique and quilting **must** be done by hand.
3. Work **must** be completed in 2010 - 2011.
4. All four sides, when added together, must measure a minimum of 216 inches total.

Judging Criteria:

Overall appearance	15 points
Difficulty of pattern	15 points
Consistency of stitches	10 points
Matching points and corners	15 points
Borders and bindings	20 points
Cleanliness of work	5 points
Balance of material weights, colors and patterns	20 points
Total	100 points
