ALL SHEEP MUST HAVE A SCRAPIE TAG AND RABIES VACCINATION

REQUIREMENTS FOR ENTERING:

1. PREREGISTER by mail Before Saturday, August 14, 2010.
2. Read carefully the RULES FOR ENTERING on the back of the Livestock Entry Form.
3. Any animal or group of animals NOT PREREGISTERED BY AUGUST 14th, WILL NOT BE ALLOWED to participate. NO EXCEPTIONS.
4. You MUST list Department number, Class letter and Lot number for each entry.
5. Owner MUST show his/her own animal in each class. If exhibitor has two animals, another youth may help him/her show.
6. All animals MUST be free of disease and ticks.
7. The Superintendent reserves the right to reject any animal not in good condition or not properly fitted for show. This rule will be strictly enforced.
8. All sheep MUST be in pens by 9:00 AM on Saturday, Sept. 4. Enter at the NORTH GATE ONLY.
9. Judging will start at 9:30 AM, Saturday. Release times will be at the discretion of the Superintendent on Saturday evening.
10. All sheep MUST have a RABIES VACCINATION 30 days before show date and have a certificate signed and dated by a veterinarian.
11. Health papers will be checked by the Sheep Superintendent upon arrival. Acceptance or rejection of sheep upon arrival will be left up to the discretion of the Superintendent and / or health officials.
12. If you are coming from out of state you will need an interstate health paper.
13. Any sheep, including wool breeds, not properly cleaned or fitted for show will be rejected at the discretion of the Sheep Superintendent.
14. If for any reason you cannot attend after PREREGISTERING you MUST notify the Sheep Superintendent in order to be eligible for the following year.
15. Premiums will be paid by mail before September 30, 2010.
16. JUDGING WILL BE DONE BY THE DANISH SYSTEM. All judging results are final.
17. Papers for Flock classes must be presented in the ring.
18. Sheep must be owned 30 days prior to show.
