5. Judging will be by the Danish System, except where otherwise stated.

4. All products displayed in the cubical must originate from the same farm.

Straight judging in this class.

Requirements for Entering:

1. Vegetables attached to a board no larger than 18" x 18".
2. Vegetable portraits must be able to be hung for judging.
3. The best will be hung for display. Space may limit display.
4. The cow head vegetable portrait must be made mostly of any variety of vegetable(s). Aim for 75% to 100% vegetables; 25% can be made of other materials like fruit, flowers, grasses or leaves.
5. No more than 10% seeds.
6. Nothing artificial as part of the image.
7. Only one entry per person.
