**PREMIUM: \$150.00 (per entry)**

1. Exhibitors must read and comply with all **Fair Rules and Regulations**, located on page 2, for participation in the Woodstock Fair.
2. Any Grange is eligible to exhibit; the first five to apply will be accepted.
3. All handwork must have been completed within the last two years.
4. Variety and quality will be considered.
5. All exhibits must be completed between 10:00 am and 6:30 pm on Receiving Day, Thursday, September 1, 2011.

All exhibits in this department must include the following items, arranged in a visually appealing manner, in order to be eligible to receive premium payment:

- Application of Grange Principals, including the American Flag and the Holy Bible.
- Community and Civic involvement.
- Vegetables, fruit, dairy products, honey, eggs, maple syrup, canned goods, jams and jellies, bread and pastry (covered with plastic wrap as appropriate).
- Flowers, (wild and cultivated), handwork, arts and crafts.
- Demonstration of the Fair Theme.

All items must be included in the exhibit to receive the premium; no exceptions.
