

# SPECIAL CONTEST RULES FOR ENTERING

1. For participation in the Woodstock Fair, all Exhibitors must read and comply with all **Fair Rules and Regulations**, located on page 2, in addition to “**Requirements for Entering**” listed within Special Contests.
2. All entries must be registered and postmarked no later than **Saturday, August 13, 2011**. No entries will be accepted if not registered, unless otherwise specified. Not all entries in Department 20 need to be registered.

4. To be eligible for judging, all registered entries must be brought to the fairgrounds on the proper receiving days; no exceptions.
5. **Receiving Days** are:

**Monday, September 5, 2011:** Senior Sun Bonnet Contest  
**Coloring Contest:** Mailed or delivered to the Woodstock Fair Office any time prior to Wednesday, August 24, 2011.

All other contests are people contests. Contestants please arrive at the South Stage - Family Fun Center 10 minutes before the contest begins to sign in.

All Special Contests are held “live” at the Woodstock Fair South Stage - Family Fun Center.

6. Decisions of the Judges are final.
7. Premiums will be paid by mail no later than September 30, 2011.
8. All entries must be removed after each contest. Poster and Scarecrow Contest entries must be removed on **Monday, September 5, 2011 between 7:00 pm to 9:00 pm**. No vehicles will be permitted on the grounds before 9:00 pm on Monday evening.
9. Any entry not removed by 7:00 pm on Tuesday will become the property of the Woodstock Fair and will be disposed of accordingly.
10. Reasonable supervision will be provided by the Woodstock Agricultural Society, Inc. in the safe keeping of animals, exhibits and/or any other type of property. The Society shall not be responsible for any loss, injury or death that may occur to animals, exhibits and/or property for any reason.
