Mr. Dunleavy was a past president, assistant secretary, and longtime director of special events at the Fair. "The Woodstock Agricultural Society, Inc. Raymond Donnelly Scholarship" honors the memory of the late Raymond Donnelly, best known for "Ray's Fries". "The Woodstock Agricultural Society, Inc. Preston T. Roberts Memorial Scholarship" honors the memory of the late Preston T. Roberts and is funded by the Family. Mr. Roberts was the Dairy Extension Agent for Windham and New London counties from 1954-1985. "The Woodstock Agricultural Society, Inc. Francis Stevens Memorial Scholarship" honors the years of dedication by this director and former Assistant General Manager, Francis Stevens.
