Requirements for Entering:

1. Exhibitors must read and comply with all **Fair Rules and Regulations**, located on page 3, for participation in the Woodstock Fair.
2. In any lot, an exhibitor may place only one entry, with the exception of lots 30, 39, 54, 69 and 76.
3. For "named" entries, write the variety name on the entry form, ex. "The Fairy Rose". If the variety name is unknown enter the flowers under "unnamed".
4. For "identified" entries, write the common name of the plant on the entry form ex. "Bush Clover".
5. All flowers must be grown by exhibitor. Nothing grown in a commercial garden/greenhouse is permitted.
6. Specimens entered in competition must be disease free and without insect damage.
7. Glass containers must be used - their weight helps prevent tipping.
8. Artificial or silk flowers may not be used in any of the classes.
9. To keep the displays looking fresh, superintendents, at their discretion, may dispose of some blossoms.
10. Judging will be by the Danish System except where otherwise stated.

1. Arrangement representing a particular fairy tale, using flower or plant material, as well as other accents, to create a pleasing display.

- *Crate will be provided.*
- *Crate dimensions: 17 7/8" tall x 12 1/2" wide x 9 5/8" deep.*
- *Sides and back of the crate may be used also.*
- *Display must be 2/3 plant material.*
- *Limited to the first 10 entries.*

2. Create an arrangement in a watertight METAL watering can (no plastic cans will be accepted).
 - Container must be no larger than 15" across.
 - Garden should be 80% plant material.

CLASS G ARRANGEMENTS

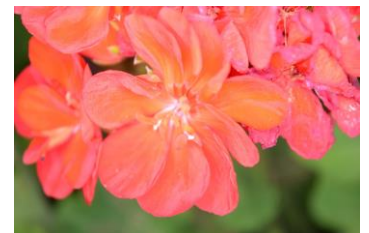
*Arrangement of fresh cut flowers (no artificial),
judged by artistic arrangement, attractiveness and quality.*

- 56. Arrangement in a low container, table centerpiece, overall height 9"
- 57. Arrangement in a basket, must be water tight, maximum height 24"
- 58. Arrangement in a vase or bowl, maximum height 24"
- 59. Miniature "Cupcake" Arrangement
Using a standard-size silicon or foil cupcake liner, create a small arrangement that resembles a cupcake. Overall size must be 4" or less.
- 60. Arrangement in a Fruit or Vegetable
Use a hollowed out squash, pumpkin or other fruit/vegetable as the container for your arrangement. The arrangement must be watertight. Overall size must be 18" or less.
- 61. Arrangement in any unusual container, must be able to hold water, maximum height 30"
- 62. Monochromatic Arrangement, **named**, maximum height 24"
