LIVESTOCK RULES FOR ENTERING

1. For participation in the Woodstock Fair, all Exhibitors must read and comply with all **Fair Rules and Regulations**, located on page 3, the **Connecticut Fair and Show Requirements**, located on page 4, the **Memorandum** located on page 5, as well as “**Requirements for Entering**” listed within a given department.
2. All entries must be registered and postmarked no later than **Saturday, August 11, 2018**. No entries will be accepted if not registered, unless otherwise specified.

4. To be eligible for judging, all registered entries must be brought to the fairgrounds on **Receiving Day, Thursday, August 30, 2018** between 10:00 am and 7:00 pm unless otherwise stated within a given department’s requirements.
5. Decisions of the judges are final.
6. Premiums will be paid by mail no later than September 30, 2018.
7. All entries must be removed at designated times only as stated within a given department’s requirements. Premiums will be considered forfeited by any exhibitor removing animals from the fairgrounds prior to the designated release times.
8. Reasonable supervision will be provided by the Woodstock Agricultural Society, Inc. in the safe keeping of animals, exhibits and/or any other type of property. The Society shall not be responsible for any loss, injury or death that may occur to animals, exhibits and/or property for any reason.
