Requirements for Entering:

1. Exhibitors must read and comply with all **Fair Rules and Regulations**, located on page 3, for participation in the Woodstock Fair.
2. In any lot, an exhibitor may place only one entry, with the exception of lots 27, 36, 51, 66 and 77.
3. For "named" entries, write the variety name on the entry form, ex. "The Fairy Rose". If the variety name is unknown enter the flowers under "unnamed".
4. For "identified" entries, write the common name of the plant on the entry form ex. "Bush Clover".
5. All flowers must be grown by exhibitor. Nothing grown in a commercial garden/greenhouse is permitted.
6. Specimens entered must have flowers. While the flowers are the primary part judged, all plant parts (flowers, stems, buds, leaves) must be disease free and without insect damage.
7. Glass containers must be used - their weight helps prevent tipping.
8. Artificial or silk flowers may not be used in any of the classes.
9. To keep the displays looking fresh, superintendents, at their discretion, may dispose of some blossoms.
10. Best in Show Award - the overall best in **all** categories. This will be judged by all the judges to select one Best in Show. The winner will receive an additional ribbon as well as a \$10 premium.
11. Judging will be by the Danish System except where otherwise stated.

1. Arrangement that best represents your choice of theme.
 - Crate will be provided.
 - Crate dimensions: 17 7/8" tall x 12 1/2" wide x 9 5/8" deep.
 - Sides and back of the crate may be used also.
 - Display must be 80% plant material vs. other accents
 - Provide a title for your creation.
 - Be creative, the sky is the limit on this theme!
 - Limited to the first 10 entries.

CLASS G ARRANGEMENTS

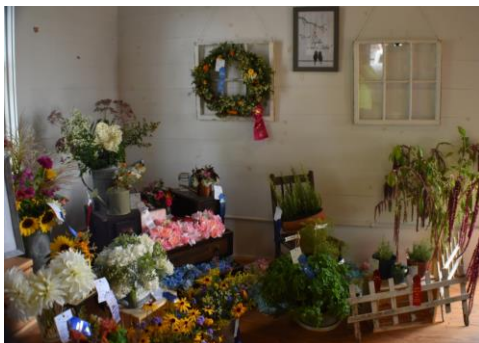
*Arrangement of fresh cut flowers (no artificial),
judged by artistic arrangement, attractiveness and quality.*

Lot No. Description

- 52. Arrangement in a single or pair of farm boots. Must have a water tight container on the inside to hold the arrangement.
- 53. Arrangement made of all edible plants. Maximum height 24".
- 54. Arrangement in a mason jar. Small, medium or large mason jars will be accepted.
- 55. Any mini arrangement in a mini container. Overall height 5" of less.
- 56. Arrangement in a wood log. Create an arrangement using a hollowed out wooden log no larger than 24" long and 12" wide. May sit vertical or horizontal. Must have a water tight container inside.
- 57. Arrangement in a watermelon. You choose the watermelon size to hollow out and place your arrangement in. Must have a water tight container inside.
- 58. Monochromatic arrangement, **named**, with sliced fruit in a glass vase. Line your vase with sliced fruit of your choice to accent your monochromatic arrangement. Create a name for your arrangement. Maximum height 24".
