

GENERAL RULES FOR ENTERING

1. For participation in the Woodstock Fair, all Exhibitors must read and comply with all **Fair Rules and Regulations**, located on page 2, in addition to “**Requirements for Entering**” listed within a given department.
2. All entries must be registered and postmarked no later than **Saturday, August 10, 2019**. No entries will be accepted if not registered, unless otherwise specified.

4. To be eligible for judging, all registered entries must be brought to the fairgrounds on the proper receiving day between 10:00 am and 7:00 pm. No exceptions.

6. Decisions of the judges are final.
7. Premiums will be paid by mail no later than September 30, 2019.
8. All entries must be removed at the following designated times only, unless otherwise specified.
Monday, September 2, 2019 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm
Tuesday, September 3, 2019 5:00 pm to 7:00 pm
No vehicles will be permitted on the grounds before 9:00 pm on Monday evening.
9. Any entry not removed by 7:00 pm on Tuesday will become the property of the Woodstock Fair and will be disposed of accordingly.
10. Reasonable supervision will be provided by the Woodstock Agricultural Society, Inc. in the safe keeping of animals, exhibits and/or any other type of property. The Society shall not be responsible for any loss, injury or death that may occur to animals, exhibits and/or property for any reason.
