REQUIREMENTS FOR ENTERING:

1. **PREREGISTER** by mail **BEFORE** Saturday, August 9, 2008.
2. Any animal **NOT PREREGISTERED WILL NOT BE ALLOWED** to participate. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
3. Read carefully the **RULES FOR ENTERING** on the back of the **Livestock Entry Form.**
4. **ONLY ONE (1) EXHIBITOR'S NAME PER ENTRY FORM.**
5. There are **NO BOARDING FEES.**
6. Juniors **MUST NOT** have reached their 19th birthday by Aug 29, 2008.
7. Classes for the Junior Show are the same as Open Show.
8. The **DEPARTMENT NUMBER for JUNIORS 8 C.**
9. You **MUST** list **Department number, Class letter** and **Lot number** for **each entry** on the entry blank.
10. **Please Note:** There are **10** classes for guinea pigs. Be sure to write the **correct** class letter with lot number on entry blank. Any animal entered in the wrong class will be disqualified. There will be **NO TAG CHANGES** the weekend of the fair.
11. **All Guinea Pigs will be received between 12:00 noon and 6:00 PM on Receiving Day, Thursday, August 28. Enter at the North Gate only.**
12. Entries will be closed when cage space is no longer available.
13. All rules and regulations set forth by the State of Connecticut Dept. of Agriculture will be strictly observed. The final decision on the health of guinea pigs to be shown will be determined by the Guinea Pig Superintendents.
14. Any guinea pig showing symptoms of sickness or disease cannot be exhibited.
15. All guinea pigs entered **MUST** be purebred, however, pedigree papers are not required.
16. All crates, boxes, carrying cages, or vehicles used for transportation of guinea pigs to the show **MUST** be thoroughly cleaned and disinfected.

18. **All judging results are final.**
19. **Premiums will be paid by mail before September 30, 2008.**
20. **Please Note:** Coup out time is at 6:00 PM on Monday. All animals **MUST** be removed by 7:00 PM. No animals may be removed before 6:00 PM.
21. Superintendents have the right to accept or reject any and all entries based on previous year's experience with entrants.
